Jefferson Community Foundation Helps Rebuild After Flood

Greetings:

The Jefferson Community Foundation was created in 1999 to receive gifts, administer funds and make distributions for charitable purposes for the benefit and improvement of residents of the Jefferson School District. Since then it has become home for funds to support both short- and long-term special projects and scholarships.

Like so many others in the community, this past year our focus emphasized the rebuilding efforts after the 2008 flood. Through generous donations from inside and outside our community, we were able to establish a Flood Recovery Fund. Through this fund, disbursements were made to the City of Jefferson for reseeding Riverfront Park and rebuilding the Candise St. pier, the Jefferson Fire Department for a computer and software to be utilized for mobile command operations, Jefferson Youth Baseball for rebuilding the concession stand at Riverfront Park, and the Jefferson Food Pantry.

In addition to more than 45 designated, special project and scholarship accounts, the Jefferson Community Foundation is home to the "Greater Jefferson Fund." The Greater Jefferson Fund was established with 20 gifts of \$5,000 each from community supporters. Income from it is available for grants to educational, cultural, charitable or benevolent causes that will benefit and improve the Jefferson School District community.

In the fiscal year that ended June 30, a new scholarship fund was established. The American Association of University Women (AAUW) established the Second Chance Grant. Thanks to the generosity of one donor, people with

an attachment to Jefferson can apply for this scholarship.

A nine-member, volunteer board of directors governs the Jefferson Community Foundation. Serving at the conclusion of the 2009 fiscal year were Barbara Mayhew, chair; Andy Didion, vice-chair; Carol Ward Knox, secretary; Steve Cross, Georgia Dettmers, Eric Felth, Michael Swartz, Dr. David Volk and Ron Wegner.

At the Foundation's re-organizational meeting for 2010, Andy Didion was elected chair, Eric Felth was elected vice-chair, and Knox continued as secretary. Mayhew, as past chair, became ex-officio. CPA representative Theresa Beck joined the board.

People with an interest in the Jefferson community are encouraged to support the Foundation. Donations can be designated to the Greater Jefferson Fund or any of those funds listed within the foundation. New funds can also be established. Applications are available from any board member or at www.Jeffersoncommunityfoundation.org.
