This public charity is organized under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. A nine-member, volunteer board of directors governs the Jefferson Community Foundation. The Jefferson City Council, School Board, Chamber of Commerce Board, Council for the Performing Arts Board and Premier Bank's Trust Department each appoint one person to serve on the board. Four at-large members are named by the board. All gifts to the Foundation are tax deductible.
